Upgrade classes are <u>RECOMMENDED</u> 10 hours per year.

All Licensed Journeymen need 30 hours of approved classes every 3 years.

<u>CPR</u>: -This is a four (4 hour) course. CPR expires after (1) year. <u>CA Approved Course.</u> Saturday, October 3rd @ 8:00AM - 12:00PM or Saturday, October 3rd @ 12:30PM - 4:30PM

<u>First Aid:</u> - This is a four (4 hour) course. CPR expires after (3) years. <u>CA Approved Course.</u> Saturday, October 3rd @ 8:00AM - 12:00PM or Saturday, October 3rd @ 12:30PM - 4:30PM

NFPA 25 Updates "ZOOM" Class - This is a six (6 hour) course delivered via Zoom.

This course will cover skills to perform the Quarterly, Annual, and Five-Year Inspections of fire sprinkler systems. The changes to Title 19 put forth by the California State Fire Marshal will be reviewed in detail. Saturday, October 10th @ 8:00AM - 2:30PM CA Approved Course.
