Sprinkler Fitters U.A. Local 483 Continuing Education Classes

To sign up for CEC Classes, Download and Use the ISAQR App on your smart phone.

Upgrade classes are **RECOMMENDED** 10 hours per year.

All Licensed Journeymen need 30 hours of approved classes every 3 years.

Cathodic Protection- This is a (4 hour) course. This course will cover Corrosion, Cathodic Protection and the materials used for a complete Cathodic Protection system. **Wear Boots and Work Clothes.**
CA Approved Course. Thursday, April 2nd 4PM-8PM

CPVC Installation- This is a (4 hour) course. This class will cover the code requirements regarding CPVC Installation as well as manufacturers' best practices. **Wear Boots and Work Clothes.**
CA Approved Course. Thursday, April 4th 4PM-8PM

Foremanship-This is an (8 hour) course. This class is intended to provide training to sprinkler fitters to learn and understand the skills necessary to perform effectively as a Foreman, Superintendent, or in other leadership positions. This class is also designed to emphasize the importance of a field foreman to the company; to review the primary responsibilities of the foreman; to understand the qualifications to become a foreman and to help understand the people you work with.
CA Approved Course. Saturday, April 13th 8AM-4:30PM

Advanced ITM's for Valves- This is a (4 hour) course. This course will cover in depth the Inspection, Testing and Maintenance of fire protection dry valves, single interlock preaction valves and double interlock preaction valves for quarterly, annual, and five-year ITMs. **Wear Boots and Work Clothes.**
CA Approved Course. Tuesday, April 16th 4PM-8PM

Through Penetration Fire Stopping- This is a (4 hour) course. In this course you will learn when, how and which type of fire stopping to use on the jobsite as well as the compatibility of firestopping materials with CPVC piping and fittings. **Wear Boots and Work Clothes. CA Approved Course.**
Tuesday, April 23rd 4PM-8PM

Fire Protection Technology- This is a (4 hour) course. This course will cover how to download, navigate and search the various NFPA codebooks applicable to the fire protection field. The student will also learn how to download, fill out, save, and send NFPA 25 reports on either a laptop or tablet device. **CA Approved Course. Thursday, April 25th 4PM-8PM**

Advanced Fire Pump Installation- This is a (4 hour) course. This class will cover the task of installing and testing various types of Fire Pumps. NFPA codes and Standards will be discussed.
Wear Boots and Work Clothes. CA Approved Course. Tuesday, June 4th 4PM-8PM

ASSE 15010 ITM- This is a forty (40 hour) course - ** Laptop Required** This class will guide you through the inspection requirements of NFPA 25 and discuss the installation requirements that are not addressed in NFPA 25. It will also include the testing of systems as required by NFPA 25 and best practices for those systems that lack the documentation to ensure that the required tests are performed. Best practices will be covered under the maintenance requirements, including some tips of the trade. At the end of this course, the attendee will be given the opportunity to get a certification for ITM that includes both a written and practical test that goes beyond the NICET certification. This course will consist of 7 (seven) classes and 1 (one) test day.

Advanced Fire Pump Acceptance- This is a (4 hour) course. In this course the student will learn the proper documentation and test for system acceptance of new Fire Pump installations as well as the inspections, testing and maintenance of Fire pumps. The student will become more knowledgeable in the NFPA 20 and NFPA 25 California Edition. **Wear Boots and Work Clothes.**

CA Approved Course. Thursday, June 6th 4PM-8PM

Advanced Fire Pump Packing and Alignment- This is a (4 hour) course. In this course the student will learn how to align a fire pump that is out of alignment using various tools and methods. The student will also learn how to fill the annular space between the box and shaft of the fire pump so the packing may come as close as practical to the pump shaft without actually touching it.

Accelerators and Thermostatic Releases- This is a (4 hour) course. In this course students will learn how identify which systems Accelerators and Thermostatic Releases are used. As well as the operations, installation and repairs of the various Accelerators and Thermostatic Releases.

Aerial Platform- This is a four (4 hour) class- This course will cover the training that is required by Osha for the operation of AWP's on the jobsite. A Digital card will be issued upon the completion of the class. **Wear Boots and Work Clothes. CA Approved Course.**

Tuesday, June 18th 4PM-8PM, Saturday, June 22nd 8AM-12:00PM

Gradall-This is a four (4 hour) course – This course will cover the training required by OSHA for the operation of Gradall/Telehandlers on the jobsite. A Digital card (valid for 3 years) will be issued upon the successful completion of the class. **Wear Boots and Work Clothes. CA Approved Course.**

Thursday, June 20th 4PM-8PM, Saturday, June 22nd 12:30PM-4:30PM

Bracing and Restraints- This is a (4 hour) course. This class will cover all the code requirements for Bracing and Restraint systems dealing with Fire Sprinklers. This will include all accepted practices along with new and innovative technologies. **CA Approved Course.** Tuesday, June 25th 4PM-8PM

Advanced Underground- This is a (4 hour) course. This course will cover the NFPA 25 CA edition for inspection, testing and maintenance of Underground piping and Fire Hydrants. Also, the frequencies of when the ITMs are to be performed and the tools and materials needed to conduct the ITMs. This course will also include the use of iPads to fill out the applicable AES forms digitally.
