Local Measures

- **Daly City - Measure Q** – ½¢ Sales tax for City services

- **East Palo Alto – Measure V** – Increase hotel tax from 12% to 14% in 2 steps for affordable housing
Recommend YES
- **Half Moon Bay - Measure U** – Increase hotel tax from 12% to 15% in 2 steps for general revenue
Recommend YES
- **San Bruno – Measure S** – If Cannabis businesses are allowed, tax up to 10% of gross
Recommend YES
- **San Bruno – Measure X** – Increase hotel tax from 12% to 14% in for city services and facilities
Recommend YES
